IMPROVED STREETS & ADA RAMPS COMING TO MONTEREY NEIGHBORHOODS

Monterey, CA.— Starting September 12, the City of Monterey will construct ADA ramps and improve streets in the Villa Del Monte, Old Town, Monterey Vista and Skyline Forest neighborhoods. On-street parking may be restricted, streets and sidewalks may be closed intermittently, and detours may be in place through the month of November. Construction will occur intermittently from 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the following streets:

- Montecito Avenue and Dela Vina Avenue from September 12 – October 3
- Van Buren and Scott Streets from September 26 - October 17
- Mar Vista Drive and Via Zaragoza from October 21 - November 11
- Greenwood Vale, Forest Rise, Forest Vale, Shepherd's Place and Wright's Place in the Skyline Forest neighborhood from October 31 - November 21

The project involves street surface grinding and asphalt replacement, and the demolition and construction of sidewalk and curb ramps. Construction will be followed by street marking and striping. Funding for the project comes from Measure P, the Neighborhood Improvement Program, Capital Improvement Program and federal Community Development Block Grant funds.
