Appeals Hearing Board (meets as needed)

The Appeals Hearing Board conducts public hearings to contest fees, charges, costs, expenses, penalties, or other sums of money owed to the City, with the authority to allow the imposition of liens, special assessments, special collections or other collection processes.

Architectural Review Committee (meets on first and third Wednesdays at 4:00 p.m.)

The Architectural Review Committee reviews the design and appearance of all new commercial, industrial and multi-family buildings, selected single family residences and signs to insure orderly and harmonious development. It also provides advisory recommendations to the City Council on matters involving design guidelines and appearance of City initiated development. Interest in and knowledge of architecture, design, and landscaping are important considerations for Architectural Review Committee appointments.

Building and Housing Appeals Board (meets as needed)

The Building and Housing Appeals Board conducts public hearings to decide appeals of orders, decisions, or determinations made by the Building Official relative to the application and interpretation of the California Building, Fire, Plumbing, Mechanical, and Electrical Codes and to allow the imposition of liens, special assessments, special collections or other collection processes.

Colton Hall Museum/Cultural Arts Commission (meets on fourth Mondays at 4:00 p.m.)

The Colton Hall Museum/Cultural Arts Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters pertaining to the history and program development of the Colton Hall Museum, and cultural arts funding and programs.

Disabled Access Appeals Board (meets as needed)

The Disabled Access Appeals Board conducts public hearings of appeals to decide appeals of orders, decisions, or determinations made by the Building Official or the City's Americans with Disabilities Act Coordinator relative to the application, interpretation, unreasonable hardship requests, or alternate means of compliance with both State and Federal disabled access regulations and to allow the imposition of liens, special assessments, special collections or other collections processes.

Historic Preservation Commission (meets on second Thursdays at 4:00 p.m.)

The Historic Preservation Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters pertaining to the preservation of buildings and other landmarks of historical value.

Library Board of Trustees (meets on fourth Wednesdays at 5:00 p.m.)

The Library Board of Trustees is an administrative Board and it governs personnel, policy and other matters concerning the Monterey Public Library.

Measure P Oversight Committee (meets at least quarterly and as needed)

The purpose of the committee is to ensure that Measure P revenues are expended only for the purposes described in the ordinance. The committee's specific duties are as follows:

- a. Review receipts and expenditures of the Measure P special tax
- b. Prepare and present an annual independent report to the City Council

Parks and Recreation Commission (meets on third Thursdays at 7:00 p.m.)

The Parks and Recreation Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters pertaining to the maintenance and development of the City's parks and various recreation programs.

Planning Commission (meets on second and fourth Tuesdays at 4:00 and 7:00 p.m., and occasional study session and subcommittee meetings)

The Planning Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council on matters pertaining to the development and maintenance of the General Plan, Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Ordinance of the City. It also reviews and acts on applications for development approval, including use of land and buildings, height and bulk of buildings, open space regulations, parking requirements, etc.
