Over the past several months, the Monterey Police Department has investigated a series of residential burglary and prowling incidents. These incidents included the following:

On July 11, 2020 at approximately 1:30 p.m., Monterey Police Officers investigated a report of a past tense subject prowling outside a residence in the 300 block of Hannon. After reviewing home surveillance video, the victim discovered the prowling had occurred earlier that morning at approximately 4:40 a.m.

On August 1, 2020 at approximately 9:12 p.m., Seaside Police Officers were dispatched to a report of a burglary in progress in the 900 block of Trinity in Seaside. Witnesses reported a subject fleeing the residence and the homeowner was not present. Officers searched the area but the subject was not located.

On September 4, 2020 at approximately 2:21 a.m., Monterey Police Officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Edinburgh for a report of a subject prowling outside a residence. Officers responded to the area and contacted Alvaro Asevedo, 39 years old of Monterey, walking through the neighborhood. The investigation at that time could not confirm that Asevedo was responsible for the prowling and he was released.

Later the same day, on September 4, 2020 at approximately 4:12 p.m., Monterey Police Officers investigated a past tense prowling outside a residence in the 200 block of Lerwick. After reviewing home surveillance video, the victim discovered the prowling occurred earlier on September 4th at approximately 1:40 a.m. Upon reviewing the home surveillance video, officers positively identified Asevedo as the suspect based on their previous interaction with him earlier in the neighborhood.

On September 6, 2020, Monterey Police Officers investigated a past tense burglary to a residence in the 200 block of Lerwick. The victim reported a subject attempted to enter the residence through an open window but fled prior to getting all the way inside. Home surveillance video captured the subject and officers again positively identified the suspect as Asevedo. Officers were actively looking for Asevedo, however his whereabouts were unknown.

On September 14, 2020 at approximately 1200 p.m., Monterey Police Officers investigated a past tense prowling in the 500 block of Ramona. After reviewing home surveillance video, the victim discovered the prowling occurred earlier on September 14th at approximately 4:40 a.m. Upon reviewing the video, officers again identified the suspect as Asevedo.

On September 18, 2020 at approximately 10:30 p.m., Monterey Police Officers located Asevedo walking in the area of English and Del Monte and arrested him for burglary and he was booked into the Monterey County Jail.
